# Latonia Terrace:

-It's Hot, now is the time to check out your front and rear yards. Sweep up any dead leaves, debri, glass and trash that you can put eyes on around your apartment. Call in work order if you have torn up window blinds and broken parts on your storm doors. Wipe down your doors and clean out your trash can regularly.

Important Notes: All Swimming Pools that are greater than 1 foot deep and 6 feet in diameter are not permitted on HAC property. These pools must be supervised by an adult whenever filled and present in the yard. Pools may not obstruct walkways or be inflated for longer than 8 hours to prevent damage to lawns. If lawncare requires the pools to be moved to complete lawncare, residents are expected to comply immediately. Violators of this rule will result in a lease termination notice for eviction.
